### 8. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY

Economic Development Facilitator (CN) (\$ Massey) presented an overview of Economic Development (see **Attachment C**).

Discussion points included:

- The region needs to consider developing a clear strategic plan (especially for overseas markets). What do we want to focus on? What jobs do we want to create?
- Need to concentrate on three focus areas only.
- Focus could be on existing or emerging industries.
- The coal industry is diminishing and there will be a need to transition markets over the next 20 years.
- Focus should consider a knowledge-based workforce.
- Modelling is required to identify path forward. What do we have now and how do we
  get to where we want to be? Needs to be place-based. How do the players sit in this
  concept?

- How do we successfully attract and recruit suitable workforce from Universities outside of the Newcastle Region?
- EDS document needs to be action orientated.
- EDS needs to consider the wider Newcastle Region and not just the LGA.
